- 1                   An act to fault pedestrians in automobile accidents that occur in unmarked zones

- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5   Section 1: When a pedestrian is hit by a car in an unmarked zone, the driver is not responsible for health
- 6   care costs unless they were breaking another written law.
- 7
- 8   Section 2: When the accident is reported, it must be stated that the pedestrian was not in a cross-walk
- 9   when hit.
- 10
- 11   Section 3: If the driver was above the speed limit or under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, the driver is
- 12   still at fault.
- 13
- 14   Section 4: If a pedestrian is hit in a marked zone or cross walk, the driver will continue to be at fault.

- 16   Section 5: This bill will go into effect immediately upon passage.
