1 An act to relating to drone surveillance.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The "Citizens' Freedom from the Unwarranted Surveillance Act" would prohibit the use of drones
6 for lethal and surveillance purposes in Kentucky. It will preserve our privacy rights as Kentuckians and our
7 rights as Americans.

9 Section 2: A "drone" is defined as an unmanned aircraft. The FAA predicts that between 10,000 to 30,000
10 drones could be lurking in our skies by 2020, many of which could be carrying lethal payloads and advanced
11 surveillance technology. Problems with drones have been gaining national attentions such as spying or
12 "peeping tom" drones, armed drones and giving too much power to law enforcement.

14 Section 3: The use of unwarranted surveillance of drones violates Sections 2, 10, and 11 of the Kentucky
15 Constitution.

17 Section 4: This bill would prohibit law enforcement agencies from gathering evidence with a drone without a
18 warrant.

20 Section 5: This bill would NOT prohibit law enforcement for using drones to search for missing people. This
21 bill would also allow private companies to use drones as long as they don't carry lethal weapons.

23 Section 6: This bill will require drone enthusiasts to purchase a license in order to use their drones in the
24 Commonwealth of Kentucky. If a citizen breaks a rule pertaining to drones, they will have their license
25 revoked and will be given a fine up to \$5,000 depending on the severity of said offense.

27 Section 7: This bill will go into effect upon six months after passage.
