An act to change the way you sign up to be an organ donor

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Right now if you want become an organ donor you sign the back of your license and check yes. Also if you die then your parents have the right to say no about you being an organ donor. The DMV aren't required to ask you if you want to be an organ donor when you renew/get a new license.

Section 2: We want to change that your parents can't change your decision on being an organ donor if you die.
