1	An act to require all law enforcement personnel to wear mobile body cameras on their uniforms in the
2	Commonwealth of Kentucky.
3	
4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5	
6	Section 1: With the increase of accusations of police brutality and crime rates, accurate evidence will help to
7	either convict or acquit a suspect. These cameras will provide a way to document evidence. In Rialto,
8	California, within the first year of wearing body cameras, the use of force by officers declined by 60% and
9	the citizen complaints again the police decreased by 88%.
10	
11	Section 2: The cameras will be located on the officer's chest plate. Officers will be required to turn on their
12	camera when they clock in for their shift. It will be enforced by the local Police Chief, as well as the local and
13	state governments.
14	
15	Section 3: The cost for one camera is an average of \$300. The funds for this bill will be provided by the
16	Kentucky Department of Homeland Security and Department of Justice.
17	
18	Section 4: This bill will go into effect 6 months after passage.
