- 1 An act to require KEES money to be repaid for students who drop out of college.
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill requires a college student to pay back KEES money they were given if they drop out of
- 6 college after their first year. Currently, the recipient of any KEES money is allowed to keep the money even if
- 7 they drop out of college. This bill is needed to ensure students will not be able to take advantage of the KEES
- 8 money program.

- 10 Section 2: The purpose of this bill is to make sure students who decide to drop out of college repay any
- 11 money given to them through the KEES program.
- 12
- 13 Section 3: Funding will come from the Kentucky Board of Education. The money the students pay back will go
- 14 to the Kentucky Board of Education. Money repaid will be distributed to future students in the KEES
- 15 program.
- 16
- 17 Section 4: Students who fail to repay KEES money if they drop out of college must perform community
- 18 service to pay off their debt. They will be required to complete 125 hours of community service.
- 19
- 20 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2016-2017 school year.
