An act to increase awareness for LGBT communities. 1 2 3 Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky 4 5 Section 1: We propose a state mandated program dedicated to LGBT discrimination awareness. This training 6 will be a minimum of 60 minutes per year for all middle and high school students. 7 8 Section 2: This program will be run by teachers accessed through the Kentucky state website: Kentucky.gov. 9 It will be unbiased and will only state the facts about the effects of discrimination. Every teacher will be 10 provided with a scripted PowerPoint. 11 12 Section 3: Materials will be created and provided by the Trevor Project, a charity organization whose 13 purpose is to provide LGBT awareness. 14 15 Section 4: Schools that do not fulfill this yearly requirement will receive a corrective action plan from the 16 state. If the school continues to ignore this requirement the state will remove the school's accreditation. 17

Section 5: This bill will go into effect August of 2015.
