- 1 An act to require Kentucky state roads to be replaced with Solar Roadways.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: Solar Roadways are adapted solar panels that serve as roads. These panels come in hexagonal
- 6 platforms that contain solar panels. The solar panels store energy that can be consumed by our state. We
- 7 propose to replace all roadways, sidewalks, and parking lots with solar panels. Installed inside the panels are
- 8 LED lights that will replace our currently painted road lines and signs. It also includes a built-in heater to melt
- 9 snow and or ice making winter travel safer.

- 11 Section 2: solar panels will replace costly heat absorbing asphalt while creating an energy-generating
- 12 infrastructure that will replace our reliance on fossil fuels. In turn, this will produce thousands of jobs that
- 13 will continue to fuel our economy.

- 15 Section 3: The cost to replace asphalt with solar panels will be financed from the current Kentucky
- 16 Transportation Cabinet.

- 18 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1st 2016 due to necessary training required for installation
