1	An act to strengthen security in jails across Kentucky.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Security will be increased through training all employees in jails across the Commonwealth.
6	Training will include emergency procedures, security, self-defense, and safety courses.
7	
8	Section 2: Approved training sessions and lengths will vary according to the staff positions and amount of
9	interaction with inmates.
10	
11	Section 3: The cost for employers and the state will be free, because the training sessions are already being
12	held at correctional facilities across the state. Workers will be scheduled individually to attend training
13	sessions during their work hours.
14	
15	Section 4: Lengths of training sessions will be as followed:
16	Minor staff (office staff, janitorial staff, cafeteria staff, etc.) – 7 hours per year. pass or fail test for
17	certification.
18	Major staff (guards, deputies, etc.) – 20 hours per year/pass or fail test for certification.
19	
20	Section 5: This bill will have no additional cost for implementation.
21	
22	Section 6: This bill will go into effect July 1st of the year following this bill passage. Certification hours will be
23	due July 1st of the following year after the enactment of bill.
