- 1 An act to use classification of felonies to determine return of voting rights after probation.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill will classify felonies to determine the regaining of voting rights after probation.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: Felons who have not committed a Class A, B, or C felony and have successfully completed
- 8 probation are eligible to regain their voting rights. Class D offenses include 1st degree stalking, reckless
- 9 homicide, felonious driving, and unauthorized use of a credit card when the amount charged is between
- 10 \$500.00 and \$1000.00.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: In the past, felons that have committed a Class D felony have not been able to regain their voting
- 13 rights. Upon enactment of this bill, probated Class D felons would have their voting rights restored.

- 15 Section 4: This bill has no cost.
- 16
- 17 Section 5: This bill will be enacted July 1 of the following year after passage.
