1	An act to require mandatory Ignition Interlock Devices for individuals with a DUI conviction for one year.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Require IID for any Kentucky resident convicted of a DUI, driving on a suspended license, or
6	refusing a chemical test. The cost incurred for the IID will be a one time fee of \$100.00 for installation,
7	then a monthly monitoring fee ranging from \$50.00 to \$100.00, and will be the responsiblitiy of the
8	convicted offender. The IID law will be added once the requirements for the current suspension of license
9	when convicted of a DUI is fullfilled.
10	Ignition Interlock Device Requirements:
11	(a) First DUI conviction there will be a minimum period of six months with the IID installed
12	(b) Second DUI conviction there will be a minimum of one year with the IID installed
13	(c) Third DUI Conviction there will be a minimum of five years with the IID installed
14	
15	Section 2: IID's are Ignition Interlock Device. DUI – driving under the influence. To be convicted of a DUI in
16	the state of Kentucky you must have a safe blood alcohol concentration of less than or equal to 0.08% for
17	anyone twenty one years or older, and less than or equal to 0.02% for anyone under the age of twenty one
18	
19	Section 3: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Judicial System

21	Section 4: This bill will be enacted July 1, 2015
