1 An act to lower the legal blood donor age to 15 years of age with parental consent.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: This bill will lower the legal blood donor age to 15 years of age with parental consent.

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7 Section 2: The Kentucky Blood Center is increasingly becoming dependent on high school blood drives.
8 Someone needs blood every two seconds and every three seconds someone is in need of a blood
9 transfusion.

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11 Section 3: This bill will not require any additional funding.

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13 Section 4: The Kentucky Blood Center will be responsible for these new regulations.

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15 Section 5: This bill will go into effect six months after passage.
