1                   An act to reduce the amount of money paid by military branches for state income taxes.  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: Presently in Kentucky, people pay 5.8 percent as tax on income between \$8001 and \$75,000  
6   annually. We want this tax to reduce to 5.2 percent for militants.  
7  
8   Section 2: This bill will only be in play for militants for the number of years they serve and for, once they  
9   retire, the same amount of years.  
10  
11   Section 3: This bill will only apply to militants who are born in Kentucky.  
12  
13   Section 4: When taking a corporal’s salary (who has 5-6 years of experience) of \$22,717 and reducing the  
14   tax rate to 5.2 percent, the amount paid for tax goes from \$1317.59 to \$1181.28.  
15  
16   Section 5: The state of Kentucky consists of approximately 4,339,367 people. From Kentucky, there are  
17   approximately 45,500 militants. The bill will only affect the state government income off of militants by  
18   approximately 4%.  
19  
20   Section 6: This bill does not apply for veterans or give them any other for on benefits unless they have  
21   retired after 1997, in which case they would receive the same amount of reduction for the number of years  
22   they have served.  
23  
24   Section 7: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Revenue and by the Kentucky Department  
25   of Military Affairs.  
26  
27   Section 8: This bill will be put into action a year after it has been passed on January 1st.
