- 1 An act to require all Kentucky Police departments to report statistics on civilian shootings by police.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Police departments will be required to report statistics on civilian shootings by police officers. The
- 6 statistics would include dates, times, victims, the officers responsible, and the situation.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: These would be reported to the Kentucky Police Commissioner every 6 months. The statistics will
- 9 be compared and looked over.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: The statistics will then be posted on the Kentucky Police website.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: If police departments do not comply, the consequences are as follows:
- 14 First offense- written warning with 2 weeks to comply before 2nd offense.
- 15
- 16 Second offense- a visit from officials from Internal Affairs with 2 weeks to comply before 3rd offense.
- 17 Third offense- an investigation of the department by the Internal Affairs Branch of the Kentucky State
- 18 Police.
