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1 An act to require all schools to have a full time certified Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).
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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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5 Section 1: With the increase of medical conditions and allergies, there should be a Licensed Practical Nurse
6 (LPN) on school premises. This will allow all students to feel safer at school if any medical emergencies
7 should develop. This will also allow guardians to feel more comfortable sending their kids to school. The
8 LPN would perform other tasks at school, such as health screenings, hearing tests and vision tests.
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10 Section 2: The bill will take the guilt and fear off of secretaries, teachers and parents during medical
11 situations. This will enable students to feel more comfortable about their medical conditions, allergies, and
12 talking about their illnesses with a certified medical professional.
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14 Section 3: The LPN would be hired by the school or school district.
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16 Section 4: The funding for this bill will come from the school districts. No additional funds are necessary
17 because the money will be funded through tax dollars and school tuition.
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19 Section 5: The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this bill.
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21 Section 6: School districts not in compliance have fifteen days to hire an LPN. If not in compliance after
22 fifteen days, they will lose funding from the school district until an LPN is hired.

24 Section 7: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the next school year following passage. This will
25 allow time for hiring an LPN and making modifications to school buildings.
