

1	An act to allow all schools to make up to five (5) school days through online learning.
2 3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4 5 6 7	Section 1: To allow all Kentucky public and city elementary, middle, and high schools to make up to five (5) calamity days through online learning provided by the school.
8 9 10	Section 2: A calamity day is any event causing great damage, distress, or disaster, such as: a snow day, flood, or fire.
11 12	Section 3: Online learning is any assignment a teacher gives a student through an electronic device.
13 14 15	Section 4: If a student does not have access to an electronic device, that student can be assigned a "blizzard bag."
16 17 18	Section 5: A "blizzard bag" is a bag of assignments and packets a student can take home given out at the beginning of the winter season.
19 20 21	Section 6: This law will help decrease the amount of make-up school days added to the end of the school year.
22 23	Section 7: This bill will have no cost.
24 25	Section 8: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE).
26 27	Section 9: This bill will have no offenses because the bill is allowed, not required.
28 29	Section 10: All laws or parts of laws that conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.
30 31	Section 11: This bill will go into effect at the start of the new school year after passage and signature of the governor.
