- 1 An act to amend KRS 18.025 to change the state and local voting days from Tuesday to Saturday.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: To move the state and local election day from Tuesday to Saturday.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: Local means pertaining to a city, town, or small district rather than an entire state or country.
- 8
- 9 Section 3: State means of or pertaining to the central civil government or authority.
- 10
- 11 Section 4: Voting is the right to give an expression and should be made more convenient citizens in the
- 12 Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- 13
- 14 Section 5: This bill pertains to voting in the state and local level.
- 15
- 16 Section 6: The Kentucky State Board of Elections (KSBE) will enforce this bill.
- 17
- 18 Section 7: This bill will have no cost because the people who work the voting precincts are volunteers.
- 19
- 20 Section 8: This bill will have no offenses because the government runs the voting systems.
- 21
- 22 Section 9: All laws or parts of laws that are in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

- 24 Section 10: This bill will go into effect next election after passage and signature of the governor.
