1 An act to control smoking near entrances to facilities where smoking is prohibited.

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
5
6 Section 1: This bill will help prevent secondhand smoke from entering buildings where smoking is already
7 prohibited.
8
9 Section 2: Individuals smoking will be required to stay at least 50 feet from all of the entrances.
10
11 Section 3: Businesses will be responsible for marking the 50 feet distances with posted signs.

13 Section 4: Individuals not complying with this law will be subject to the following fines:
14 First offence: \$50
15 Second offence: \$150
16 Third offence: \$250
17 Each new or following offence will be increased by \$100.

19 Section 5: The law enforcement agency for each city or county will be responsible for enforcing this law.

21 Section 6: This law will go into effect one year from date of passage.
