Section 3: A \$100 fine is given to anyone that misuses an EpiPen. Parents and children will need to be trained by their family doctor in the steps to use an EpiPen. Teachers will receive training from the parents of their student that has a life threatening allergy. Teachers may receive additional training on their own.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2016.
