An act to improve teacher performance by unscheduled walk throughs performed by administration.

 Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: As of November 2014, walk throughs are not required in Kentucky. Walk throughs are a surprise visit from an administrator, to record the expectations of a teacher, and the student's knowledge on what the teacher is teaching. These walk throughs will be 10–15 minutes long. If the teacher knows that they will have a walk through, they will prefect their teaching skills for that day only. If the visits are unscheduled, the administration will see the skills on a normal day.

Section 2: All schools in Kentucky will be required to have 2 scheduled walk throughs per 9 weeks. This shall show the teachers that they need to stay on task for the entire class in case they were to have a walk through by an administrator. Individual school districts shall have the authority to have how many ever scheduled walk throughs wanted.

Section 3: The walk throughs will give the teachers feedback on their lessons and make them and their own strengths and weaknesses. It also helps the administrators to ensure that the educators are preparing students for their futures.

Section 4: This bill shall go into effect on July 1, 2016.
