- 1 An act to require all schools in the state of Kentucky to post basic nutritional facts on all food items served
2 in the cafeteria.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 6 Section 1: The posting requires a minimum of fat, sugar, calories, and protein, but the school can add more
7 information if desired.
8
- 9 Section 2: The post will be easily visible by the staff and students in the cafeteria.

- 11 Section 3: The nutritional facts will be for both breakfast and lunch.

- 13 Section 4: The principal and cafeteria manager will be responsible for making sure the information is posted.

- 15 Section 5: The implementation of their bill will be overseen by the Kentucky Department of Health.

- 17 Section 6: Offenses for noncompliance-
- 18 1st Offense- A written warning from the Department of Health and a written plan of correction
 - 19 will be assigned
 - 20 2nd Offense- A second written warning and the lunchroom manager will be put on probation for
 - 21 a one month, unpaid period.
 - 22 3rd Offense: A new manager will be appointed.
23
- 24 Section 7: No additional taxes or charges are needed to cover this bill.
25
- 26 Section 8: This bill will go into effect in the school year of 2015-2016.
