1 An act to ban Light Emitting Diode (LED) Headlights on Kentucky roads.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Light Emitting Diode lighting is better known as LED. LED headlights are available for purchase to
6 use as lighting for cars.
7
8 Section 2: This bill pertains to all Kentucky citizens who obtains a Kentucky Driver's License or a vehicle
9 registration.

11 Section 3: Law enforcement may pull over any car using Kentucky Highways if LED lights are being used. If
12 the driver has a license or a vehicle registration from another state, they will not be fined. Police or
13 authorities of the Kentucky Department of Transportation must give an explanation to any and all motorist
14 as to why they have been pulled over for inspection.

16 Section 4: LED headlights are brighter than the regular Compact Fluorescent Light (CFL) that is regularly used
17 in U.S. manufactured vehicles . When on dim, LED headlights have the equivalent brightness of the regular
18 Compact Fluorescent Light (CFL), therefore, making it dangerous for oncoming drivers.

20 Section 5: Also, LED headlights can to be harmful to our environment. LED lighting slowly releases a toxic gas
21 that contains Lead.

23 Section 6: This bill will be enforced by our State and Local Police Department as well of Department of
24 Transportation DPT's.

26 Section 7: Kentucky motorists who are not in compliance, will be given a warning and a direction to replace
27 the headlights on their first offense. Second offense, motorists will receive a ticketed fine of 100.00, plus
28 court costs; on the 3rd offense will result a 250.00 ticketed fine, plus court costs, and license suspended for
29 3 months.

31 Section 8: In order for Kentucky motorists to comply, this bill will go into effect 6 months after passage.
