

1	An act to limit welfare benefits for able bodied Kentucky Citizens.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Welfare benefits will be limited to two, and to no more than three years for able bodied Kentucky
6	citizens.
7	
8	Section 2: Able bodied citizens are those who are not effected by medical, physical, and or mental
9	disabilities.
10	
11	Section 3: This bill pertains to Kentucky citizens who are currently receiving welfare benefits, and to those
12	who may receive benefits in the future.
13	
14	Section 4: This bill puts limits on the amount of time a recipient will receive benefits.
15	
16	Section 5: In order for a person to continue to receive benefits after the 2 to 3 years limit, they must show
17	proof that they are seeking employment and or bettering themselves by attending an academic, or trade
18	school.
19	
20	Section 6: This bill, if passed, will not cost Kentucky taxpayers any money, in fact, this bill will save money for
21	the commonwealth.
22	
23	Section 7: This bill will become effective immediately after passage.
