- 1 An act to prevent the purchase of handguns without a concealed carry license.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill would prevent the purchase of a handgun without first having a concealed carry license.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: The concealed carry class would train all gun owners in proper use of handguns, which would
- 8 decrease the incidents of accidental shootings.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: The facilitator of the concealed carry class would have guns on hand for all class members to use.
- 11
- 12 Section 4: Each participant who passes the class would be issued a certificate that the participant would
- 13 show to the gun dealer before they would be allowed to purchase a handgun.
- 14
- 15 Section 5: The cost to fund this bill would come from hand gun owners.
- 16
- 17 Section 6: This bill would be enacted one year after it is passed.
