1	An act to prohibit electronic cigarettes in the Commonwealth of Kentucky in non-smoking areas.
2	
3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5	Section 1: To prohibit cigarettes in from non-smoking areas in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
6	
7 8	Section 2: Citizens will be allowed to smoke electronic cigarettes in public areas or places that allow smoking.
9 10	Section 3: A non-smoking area is an area where smoking is not allowed.
11 12 13	Section 4: An electronic cigarette is a cigarette-shaped device containing a nicotine-based liquid that is vaporized and inhaled.
14 15 16	Section 5: This law will help prevent inhalation of the chemicals in electronic cigarettes that can you give lung cancer or other diseases.
17	Section 6: This bill will have no cost.
18	
19 20	Section 7: The Kentucky Health Department (KHD) and the police will enforce this bill.
21	Section 8: People who fail to abide by this law will be punished by the following:
22	First Offence: The smoker will be fined one hundred and fifty (150) dollars by the police in the
23	Commonwealth of Kentucky.
24	Second Offence: The smoker will be fined two hundred and fifty (250) dollars by the police in the
25	Commonwealth of Kentucky.
26	Third Offence: The smoker will be fined five hundred (500) dollars by the police in the Commonwealth of
27 28	Kentucky. The offence will be repeated until the Kentuckian abides by the law.
29 30	Section 9: All laws that are in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.
31	Section 10: This bill will go into effect ninety (90) days after passage and signature of the governor.
