1 An act to treat energy drinks like alcohol.

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This would affect anyone under the age of 21. They will be prohibited from buying or consuming
6 energy drinks.

7
8 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by law enforcement, all employees of businesses that sell this product,
9 and the ABC (Alcoholic Beverage Control).

10
11 Section 3: Taxes will increase on energy drinks containing large amounts of niacin, riboflavin, taurine, and
12 guarana. This tax will be \$.10 per every dollar spent on energy drinks.

13
14 Section 4: This bill will need to be advertised upon passing to spread awareness about the new law. The
15 advertising will be paid for by the tax on the energy drinks.

16
17 Section 5: This ban does not include soft drinks, for example but not limited to Coke, Pepsi, Sprite, Mountain
18 Dew, Dr. Pepper, etc.

19
20 Section 6: All people drinking an energy drink will be asked to show their ID. If under the age of 21 you will
21 be sent to juvenile detention for anywhere up to six months and your parents may be fined up to \$1,000.
22 For the first offense a fine of \$200 will be enforced. A second offense a fine of \$400 will be enforced. A
23 third offense a fine of \$600 will be enforced. A fourth offense a find of \$800 will be enforced. For the fifth
24 offense and any other offenses a fine of \$1000 will be enforced.

25
26 Section 7: The fines collected will go towards paying for advertising our bill, the state government, and law
27 enforcement.

28
29 Section 8: This bill will go into effect six months after it is passed.
