An act to ban the use/dispension of plastic bags used in reatial stores in Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: there is no law currently in KY about getting rid of plastic bags.

Section 2: About 90% of plastic goes in to our water ways, and is killing fish, whales, and dolphins. It also affects other animals as well, such as deer and turtles.

Section 3: The CEO's of any company dispensing plastic bags will be held accountable for this law, if their company chooses to break the law. They will have to pay million dollar fines to the KY Department of Environmental Services.

Section 4: the law will take effect January 2016.
