- 1                   An act to ban the use/dispension of plastic bags used in reatial stores in Kentucky.

- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5   Section 1: there is no law currently in KY about getting rid of plastic bags.
- 6
- 7   Section 2: About 90% of plastic goes in to our water ways, and is killing fish, whales, and dolphins. It also
- 8   affects other animals as well, such as deer and turtles.

- 10   Section 3: The CEO's of any company dispensing plastic bags will be held accountable for this law, if their
- 11   company chooses to break the law. They will have to pay million dollar fines to the KY Department of
- 12   Environmental Services.

- 14   Section 4: the law will take effect January 2016.
