1	An act to increase minimum wage to \$10.10 per hour
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: The current minimum wage for the state of Kentucky is set at \$7.25 an hour which comes to an
6	annual income of \$15,080. The poverty level in the United States is currently \$23,000 a year. The 8,000
7	dollar difference is hitting many working Kentucky families hard and creating a difficult environment for
8	Kentuckians to raise their families. By raising the minimum wage to \$10.10 an hour a worker working full
9	time can make 21,008 dollars a year closing the poverty line gap to \$2,000 dollars.
10	
11	Section 2: The minimum wage increase will occur in three steps following the passage of this bill:
12	January 1, 2016 – Increase to \$8.10 an hour
13	January 1, 2017– Increase to \$9.10 an hour

14 January 1, 2018 – Increase to \$10.10 an hour
