1 An act to repeal Amendment 1 to section 233A of the Kentucky Constitution and to legalize same sex
2 marriage.

3
4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: The Amendment to be repealed reads "only a marriage between one man and one woman shall be
7 valid or recognized as a marriage in Kentucky. A legal status identical or substantially similar to that of
8 marriage for unmarried individuals shall not be valid or recognized."

9
10 Section 2: Same sex marriage shall be legalized and recognized in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

11
12 Section 3: All laws and regulations concerning marriage in the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall be granted
13 to same sex marriages.

14
15 Section 4: All existing marriage rights should be extended to same sex marriages.

16
17 Section 5: This bill should go into effect upon passage.
