- 1 An act to require all people 75 years of age or older to retake their physical driver's test
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: All driver's 75 years of age or older must retake the physical part of their driver's test to make
- 6 sure they have the physical and mental capacity to drive safely.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: This applies to everyone in the Commonwealth of Kentucky
- 9
- 10 Section 3: A driver's test is an official assessment which must be passed in order to receive a driver's
- 11 license. A driver's license is a document permitting someone to drive a motor vehicle.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: People 75 and older will be mailed reminders to come in and retake their test every other year.
- 14
- 15 Section 5: The penalties will be as follows: First Offense - \$100 fine, Second Offense - \$150 fine, and
- 16 Third Offense - License will be revoked until they retake the test.
- 17
- 18 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on January 2015. This proposal requires no funding.
