- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: The civil statutes of limitations for child abuse is currently one year.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: This act will abolish the civil statutes of limitations of child abuse in the state of Kentucky
- 8
- 9 Section 3: Child abuse shall be defined as an act, or a failure to act, on the part of a parent or caretaker that
- 10 results in death, serious physical or emotional harm, sexual abuse, or exploitation of a child or which places
- 11 the child in an imminent risk of harm.

- 13 Section 4: The definition of statute of limitation is; a statute prescribing a period of limitations for the
- 14 bringing of a certain kind of legal actions.

- 16 Section 5: This bill will go into effect upon passage.
