- 1 An act to change the current regulations on how ESL students are tested.
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill is to change the amount of time an ESL student waits before taking state testing.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: We will change the wait by giving the ESL student a pretest before they take standardized state
- 8 testing. If the ESL student gets a passing score, then they student may proceed to take state testing. If the
- 9 ESL student does not get a passing score on the pretest, they will receive another year of English immersion.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: One student may get up to two extensions.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: This bill will take effect in all Kentucky public schools, and will require \$6287 for every four years
- 14 of test construction.
- 15
- 16 Section 5: The Kentucky Department of Education will oversee the completion of this project and will fund it
- 17 as well. If a county or specific school refuses to comply with this bill, then that county (or school) will lose
- 18 state funding, until they comply.
- 19
- 20 Section 6: This bill will take effect August 1, 2016.
