An act to prevent the re-sale of Kentucky government aid.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Receivers of Kentucky EBT (government aid) can only have free or reduced prices on official EBT items or state government approved items.

Section 2: To prevent the re-sale of Kentucky EBT or Kentucky government aid each item should have a government approved packaging to receive benefits. If the item does not contain government approved packaging the transaction shall be denied and subjected to full price.

Section 3: The state government approved packaging shall be made by the product manufacturer. The government will compensate the product manufacturer for the creation and distribution of the government aid packaging.

- Section 4: Based on the severity of the situation the penalty will be as follows:
- 17 First Offense- Take away privileges for one month.
- Second Offense- \$250 fine with three months of privileges lost or pay \$500 and regain privileges before the
- 19 time period has passed.
- Third Offense- \$500 fine and six months of loss of privileges.
- 21 Fourth Offense- Complete loss of privileges and no chance of regaining.

23 Section 5: This bill will take effect by January 1, 2016.
