- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: Property owners will receive tax deductions for their property being more energy efficient.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: When a property owner decreases his payments on the energy bill by 4%, a 1% deduction will be
- 8 provided for all energy consumption related taxes. This will create a base number, which we will determine
- 9 by taking the average of the energy consumption bills from 2000-present year.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: These tax deductions will not have any monetary impact on the state of Kentucky’s government.

- 13 Section 4: This bill will be enacted January 1st, 2015.
