- 1 An act to include offender age at time of offense on sex offender registry.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Currently, the age of an offender of a sexual offense at the time the crime was perpetrated is not
- 6 required on the description of the offense in the sex offender registry. Therefore, an offender who is a minor
- 7 is classified in the same way as an adult. While all sex crimes are serious in nature, the age at which the
- 8 crime is committed has an impact on how the crime is viewed. Therefore, the age in which the offender
- 9 commits the crime should be included.
- 10
- 11 Section 2: When registered as a sex offender, the sex offender registry will include the age of the offender at
- 12 the time of the offense specified in the tier status. The tier status will be noted if the crime was committed
- 13 by a minor.
- 14
- 15 Section 3: The Kentucky state police sex offender registry will note it in the registration.
- 16
- 17 Section 4: This bill will require no additional funding.
- 18
- 19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect one year after passage.
