An act to make enrolling homeschool students accountable on their abilities.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill will put into place a structured system that is designed to provide guidelines for home school students and parents enrolling to a public school setting.

Section 2: An enrolling home school student must submit an annual portfolio including proof of student progress consisting of child's work, pictures of child's activities, child's assessments, and other progress monitoring evidence.

Section 3: When the child enrolls to public school, he/she will share how they were educated at home and how they feel in the home environment they live in to his or her classroom teacher or counselor within the first month he or she is enrolled in school. Any concerns of the teacher or counselor regarding the placement of the child needs to be sent to the school's principal and the school district's central office.

Section 4: A universal screener will be taken by all home school students in order to determine where he/she may be placed in a public school setting.
