- 1 An act to require every public high school to provide drug screenings for all High School Athletes.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: The purpose of our bill is t require that all public high schools in Kentucky drug test athletes twice
- 6 a season while their sport is being played. By doing this, we hope to prevent Kentucky athletes from
- 7 substance.

- 9 Section 2: This bill will affect all Kentucky High School athletes in public school This bill will require a public
- 10 health official to come in twice a season, once at the beginning and again before major competition.
- 11 Athletes will be tested for performance enhancing drugs and other illegal substances.

- 13 Section 3: The consequences for not implementing a drug test for a district would be ineligible to compete at
- 14 a state level competition.
- 15
- 16 Section 4: This law will be funded by raising school taxes 0.1% to provide all districts in Kentucky enough
- 17 money to purchase eh drug testing kits for athletes.

- 19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect the school year of August, 2016.
