- 1 An act to require first aid & CPR training for all school bus drivers
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Currently, there is only one hour of mandatory first aid training required for school bus drivers.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: This bill will require all school bus drivers, including sub drivers, to complete first aid & CPR
- 8 training. All training would be required within the first 30 days of the start of school. Substitute drivers
- 9 would have 60 days to complete their training. Full-time drivers would be ineligible to drive if they are not
- 10 trained after 30 days.

- 12 Section 3: School districts would be responsible for training. Training can be accessed from the Red Cross or
- 13 local health departments. Transportation directors will show proof of drivers' training to the Kentucky
- 14 Department of Education. Drivers will be required to re-certify their training every two years.
- 15
- 16 Section 4: Upon passage, this bill will take affect in the 2015-2016 school year.
