- 1                   An act to require a yearly building inspection in all Kentucky Public Schools.

- 3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5   Section 1: If this bill were passed it would require every public school in Kentucky to have an inspection due
- 6   to hazardous molds and infestations. This bill is to protect the health of the students.
- 7
- 8   Section 2: There is sufficient evidence that links indoor exposure to mold with upper respiratory tract
- 9   symptoms, cough, and wheezing in healthy people.
- 10
- 11   Section 3: Molds can be found in every environment and can be detected. Mold growth can be found in
- 12   places where it is most warm and humid. Many infestations could occur such as rats, and different kinds of
- 13   bugs.

- 15   Section 4: The funding for the inspection and construction (if needed) will come from the school districts'
- 16   budget. it will be fairly cheap however if major structural damage is found, the school will be shut down
- 17   immediately until the issue is resolved.
- 18
- 19   Section 5: The inspection and construction (if needed) will take place at the beginning of the districts' annual
- 20   summer break. The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this bill to create a safer learning
- 21   atmosphere, for the future leaders of the Commonwealth.

- 23   Section 6: This bill will be effective starting June 20, 2015.
