1	An act to require a yearly building inspection in all Kentucky Public Schools.
2 3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7	Section 1: If this bill were passed it would require every public school in Kentucky to have an inspection due to hazardous molds and infestations. This bill is to protect the health of the students.
, 8 9 10	Section 2: There is sufficient evidence that links indoor exposure to mold with upper respiratory tract symptoms, cough, and wheezing in healthy people.
10 11 12 13 14	Section 3: Molds can be found in every environment and can be detected. Mold growth can be found in places where it is most warm and humid. Many infestations could occur such as rats, and different kinds of bugs.
15 16 17 18	Section 4: The funding for the inspection and construction (if needed) will come from the school districts' budget. it will be fairly cheap however if major structural damage is found, the school will be shut down immediately until the issue is resolved.
19 20 21	Section 5: The inspection and construction (if needed) will take place at the beginning of the districts' annual summer break. The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this bill to create a safer learning atmosphere, for the future leaders of the Commonwealth.

Section 6: This bill will be effective starting June 20, 2015.
