1 An act to require all citizens to pass a drug test before receiving public assistance.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All welfare officers will drug test each public assistance recipient.

7 Section 2: By implementing this act, money will be saved. Instead of giving citizens money for welfare they
8 will save money by giving them a drug test.

10 Section 3: This bill will fully come into effect by January 1, 2019 Phase 1 : 1/2 of all Department of Human
11 Resource Offices will have procedures in place to enforce this act by 2015-2016. Phase 2: 3/4 of all
12 Department of Human Resource Offices will have procedures in place to enforce this act by 2017-2018.
13 Phase 3: This act will be fully enforced by 100% of Department of Human Resource Offices.

15 Section 4: The purpose of this bill is to lower the national debt of our government as well as providing
16 assistance to those who truly need it without supporting the use of illegal substances.
