An act for schools to receive credits towards educational needs in exchange for recycling.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill will require the State of Kentucky to provide credits to schools that participate in a recycling program.

Section 2: These credits will go towards educational needs such as books, technology, and field trips. Credits will equal 10 cents per one pound of recycling.

Section 3: Schools will NOT be required to recycle.

Section 4: The Department of Education and respective school districts' financial managers will work together to regulate and enforce this bill.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015/16 school year.
