5	Section 1: Applicants must possess a valid drivers license/certificate from their home country.

7	Section 2: Applicants must pass a vision test, written test, and driving test to obtain license. The written
8	test will be given in their native language.
9	
10	Section 3: License will be legal in Kentucky only and will include the statement "Temporary visitor's license for
11	driving privileges only - not valid for identification."
12	
13	Section 4: License will only be for Class D Operator's license, not any CDL class of license.
14	
15	Section 5: First time fee will be \$12 and license will be good for one year. Renewal license will be \$20 and
16 17	will be good for four years.
