## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: This bill ensures that there is an age appropriate GED exam for each generation of students who did not receive their high school diplomas. This exam will assess the student based on the curriculum and standards in place when they were in high school.

Section 2: Each citizen that seeks a GED can go to a testing center near them to take the online or paper exam and provide documentation of their age. The assessment will be tailored to the generation in which the examinee was a high school student.

Section 3: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Education.

14 Section 4: This bill will be funded by the Kentucky Department of Education. The only funding needed for this bill will be for the initial composition of the various generational exams and ensuring that they are aligned to the curriculum of that time period.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2016.
