1                   An act to create term limits for state level Representatives and state level Senators.  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5 Section 1: Presently, there are no term limits for state level Representatives or state level Senators in  
6 Kentucky. Enacting term limits will ensure vacancies for new candidates to pursue and offer a continuous  
7 flow of fresh perspectives to Kentucky's Legislature. We believe these term limits should restrict state  
8 Representatives to four terms for a total of eight years of service and state Senators to three terms for a  
9 total of twelve years of service.  
10  
11 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Secretary of State. When running for the Kentucky  
12 Legislature, candidates will be required to submit their intent to run to their County Clerk as well as the  
13 Kentucky Secretary of State to ensure term limits are not exceeded.  
14  
15 Section 3: This bill should not cost the state of Kentucky any money to enforce.  
16  
17 Section 4: This bill shall take effect for all state level Representatives and state level Senators on January 1,  
18 2015.
