- 1 An act to require citizens in Kentucky who own outdoor animals to have fenced property.
- 2
- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill will require that all Kentucky residents that own pets must fence in a section of their yard
- 6 to protect themselves from liability the animals from harm.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Pet owners must fence in the area in their yard where their animals roam unleashed.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: The purpose of this law is to reduce liability of pet owners and protect the lives of the animals.

- 12 Section 4: Enforcement will be in the hands of local animal control. The first offense will be fined \$150 and
- 13 owners have six (6) weeks to have a fence built. If they fail to build the fence, then the government will come
- 14 in and build the fence and must be reimbursed. If owners don't build the fence, pets will be taken away put
- 15 in a shelter.

- 17 Section 5: This bill will become law by May, 2015.
