1	An act to require citizens in Kentucky who own outdoor animals to have fenced property.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: This bill will require that all Kentucky residents that own pets must fence in a section of their yard
6	to protect themselves from liability the animals from harm.
7	
8	Section 2: Pet owners must fence in the area in their yard where their animals roam unleashed.
9	
10	Section 3: The purpose of this law is to reduce liability of pet owners and protect the lives of the animals.
11	
12	Section 4: Enforcement will be in the hands of local animal control. The first offense will be fined \$150 and
13	owners have six (6) weeks to have a fence built. If they fail to build the fence, then the government will come
14	in and build the fence and must be reimbursed. If owners don't build the fence, pets will be taken away put
15	in a shelter.
16	

17 Section 5: This bill will become law by May, 2015.
