An act to prohibit the use of Google Glass while driving a motorized vehicle in Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Presently in the state of Kentucky there is no law prohibiting the use of Google Glass while driving. Google Glass is a new technology that has a smart phone type screen projecting onto a lens that can allow you to receive & send messages, take pictures, used for navigation and other communication. Since a screen pops up and partially covers one eye, a driver's vision is impaired. This can also be a distraction to the driver and can lead to accidents.

Section 2: Delaware, New Jersey, and West Virginia are introducing bills that prohibit the use of Google Glass while driving. The United Kingdom is also considering banning Google Glass to drivers.

Section 3: Google Glass fines are \$25 (first offense) and then \$50, plus court costs from then on. Google Glass law will be considered a "primary" law. A primary law means that an officer can pull you over for the offense without having to witness some other violation. That is, the officer sees you with Google Glass on while driving he/she can issues a citation.

Section 4: This bill will be enforced by local and state law enforcement.
