1 An act to establish a tax-free weekend in the Commonwealth annually.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Every year families are asked to provide an increasing amount of school supplies for their
6 students. In order to provide relief for these families a tax free weekend will be established during the first
7 weekend of August annually.
8
9 Section 2: Retail outlets that collect sales tax in the commonwealth will be exempt from collecting and
10 reporting sales tax on school supplies or school related accessories from Noon on the first Friday of August
11 to Midnight the following Sunday.

13 Section 3: Funding for an awareness campaign for this bill will be taken from the Kentucky Treasury
14 Department budget. The loss of income for the state will be negligible.

16 Section 4: The state treasury department will advise and consult with businesses about the implementation
17 and execution of this bill.

19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect August, the year after passage.
