- 1 An act to require all schools to place epi-pen dispensers on each floor of the school building.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: In addition to every school being required to keep epi-pen auto injectors on each floor, each
- 6 school will also be required to maintain one epi-pen to a twenty-five student ratio.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Students in both public and private schools over the age of twelve with a prescription from a
- 9 physician will be permitted to carry their personal epi-pen with them during school hours, so that in case of
- 10 an emergency allergic reaction, the student may self inject.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: Schools, public and private, with a student/teacher ration of less than twenty-eight to one will be
- 13 eligible for government financial assistance.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: If a school is found not to be in compliance by their district superintendent during annual violation
- 16 checks, all schools will pay a fine up to %1,500 per code violation.
- 17
- 18 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year.
